EVERYONE READING ILLINOIS PRESENTS: *Executive Function and Reading Development and Disabilities: Cognitive and Neurobiological Correlates*

Executive function has been linked to reading development and reading disabilities, both at the word- and text-level. This presentation will review recent and ongoing neurocognitive work that has examined the role of executive function in decoding, reading fluency, and reading comprehension outcomes, including processing of different types of texts (e.g., stories versus science texts). Studies examining the linkages between executive function and intervention outcomes and reading growth, including the role of neurobiological predictors, will also be reviewed.
